## SKILL LEVEL - EASY

## SIZES

Finished Diameter About 3 1/2 in. ( 9 cm )
Finished Circumference About 11 1/2 in. ( 29 cm )
Finished Height About 9 in . ( 23 cm ), not including strap
Cozy is designed to fit a 40 oz Hydro Flask (or similar)

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND ${ }^{\circledR}$ HEARTLAND ${ }^{\circledR}$ (Art. \#136)
\#183 Congaree 1 ball
- LION BRAND ${ }^{\circledR}$ large-eyed blunt needle


## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS



Crochet hook size $\mathrm{H}-8$ ( 5 mm )

## GAUGE

$16 \mathrm{sc}=$ about 4 in . ( 10 cm ).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## NOTES

1. Bottle Cozy is worked from the base upwards in joined rnds.
2. When instructed to "sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below", insert your hook in the space that is under the 2 ch-7's of the previous 2 rnds and work an sc crocheting the 2 ch-7's together.
3. Strap is worked separately, back and forth in rows, and sewn to Cozy.

## BOTTLE COZY

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring.
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 6 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.
Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.
Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining sl st and each st around; join with sl st in first sc - you will have 12 sc in this rnd.
Continue to work first st of each rnd into same st as joining sl st.
Rnd 3: Ch 1, * 2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc -18 sc.
Rnd 4: Ch 1, * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc -24 sc.
Rnd 5: Ch 1, * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc -30 sc .
Rnd 6: Ch 1, * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc -36 sc .
Rnd 7: Ch 1, * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc -42 sc .
Rnd 8: Ch 1, * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc -48 sc .
Rnds 9-16: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

## Begin Lace Pattern

Rnd 17: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, (ch 5, sk next 5 sts, sc in next st) twice, ch 5 , sk next 5 sts, sc in next 7 sts, (ch 5 , sk next 5 sts, sc in next st) twice, ch 5 , sk next 5 sts, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc -18 sc and 6 ch-5 sps.
Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, (ch 5, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 5 , sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next 7 sts, (ch 5, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 5, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc.
Rnd 19: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, (ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next 7 sts, (ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sc and 6 ch- 7 sps .
Rnd 20: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, (ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next 7 sts, (ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc.
Rnd 21: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), dc in first 3 sts, ch 2, sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below, (ch 5, sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below) twice, ch 2 , dc in next 7 sts, ch 2 , sc in next ch-7 sp of Rnd 19, (ch 5 , sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below) twice, ch 2 , dc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first dc $-14 \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}-5 \mathrm{sps}$, and $4 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
Rnd 22: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, ch 2 , sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st, (ch 5 , sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 2 , sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next 7 sts, ch 2 , sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st, (ch 5 , sk next ch- 5 sp , sc in next st) twice, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc - 20 sc, 4 ch- 5 sps, and 4 ch- 2 sps.
Rnd 23: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), dc in first 3 sts, ch 3, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st, (ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp , sc in next st) twice, ch 3, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 sts, ch 3 , sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next st, (ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 3, sk next ch-2 sp, dc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first dc - $14 \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}-7$ sps, and 4 ch-3 sps.

Rnd 24: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, (ch 7 sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 7 sts, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next st, (ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next st) twice, ch 3 , sk next ch-3 sp, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc. $-20 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}-7 \mathrm{sps}$, and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.
Rnd 25: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, ch 5 , sk next ch- 3 sp , sc in next ch-7 sp of Rnd 23, ch 5 , sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below, ch 5 , sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 7 sts, ch 5 , sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below, ch 5 , sc in next ch-7 sp 2 rnds below, ch 5, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in last 4 sts; join with sl st in first sc -18 sc and 6 ch- 5 sps.

Rnds 26-33: Rep Rnd 18-25.
Rnds 34 and 35: Rep Rnd 18 twice.
Rnd 36: Ch 1, work 1 sc in each sc and 5 sc in each ch-5 sp around; join with sl st in first sc -48 sc .
Rnds 37 and 38: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.
Fasten off.

## STRAP

From RS, draw up a loop of yarn in st directly above the first st of one of the 7-st wide columns of solid sc and dc sts that run up the sides of Cozy.
Row 1: Ch 2, hdc in same st as joining, hdc in next 6 sts.
Row 2: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 7 sts.
Rep Row 2 until Strap measures about 25 in. ( 63.5 cm ), or desired length.
Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.
With yarn tail, sew end of Strap to Cozy, directly above opposite 7-st column of solid sc and dc sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
