

#### **Tension**

Gauge is not that important with amigurumi. Big or small they will be cute no matter what! Using cotton double knitting yarn and a 3mm hook should produce a toy measuring approximately 15 cm tall. As a rule, the larger the hook and the thicker the yarn, the bigger the toy!

### **Materials**

- 2.5mm crochet hook
- 10mm Toy safety eyes
- Toy filling
- Embroidery thread
- Stylecraft Special dk in the following shades:
- Lemon (50g)
- Lilac (50g)
- Candyfloss Pink (50g)

#### **Abbreviations**

### This pattern uses **UK Crochet Terms**.

ch - chain
dc - double crochet
dc2tog - double crochet 2 together
sl st - slip stitch
st(s) - stitch(es)

### **Head and Body**

Using Lemon and a 2.5mm hook, make a magic loop.

Round 1: Ch1, 6dc into loop [6 dc]

Round 2: Work 2 dc in each st around [12 dc]

Round 3: (Dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) 6 times [18 dc]

Round 4: (Dc in next 2 st, 2 dc in next st) 6 times [24

dc]

Round 5: (Dc in next 3 st, 2 dc in next st) 6 times [30 dc]

Round 6: (Dc in next 4 st, 2 dc in next st) 6 times [36 dc]

Rounds 7-12: Dc in each st around [36 dc]

Round 13: (Dc in next 4 st, dc2tog) 6 times [30 dc] Round 14: (Dc in next 3 st, dc2tog) 6 times [24 dc]

Place the safety eyes between rounds 10 and 11, spacing them 8 clear stitches apart. Taking care not to

stretch the stitches, stuff head firmly. Continue stuffing as you go.

Round 15: (Dc in next 2 st, dc2tog) 6 times [18 dc]

Round 16: (Dc in next st, dc2tog) 6 times [12 dc]

Round 17: (Dc in next 2 st, dc2tog) 3 times [9 dc]

Round 18: (Dc in next 2 st, 2dc in next st) 3 times [12 dc]

Round 19: Dc in each st around [12 dc]

Round 20: (Dc in next st, 2dc in next st) 6 times [18 dc]

Round 21: Dc in each st around [18 dc]

Round 22: (Dc in next 2 st, 2dc in next st) 6 times [24 dc]

Round 23: Dc in each st around [24 dc]

Round 24: (Dc in next 3 st, 2dc in next st) 6 times [30 dc]

Round 25: Dc in each st around [30 dc]

Rounds 26-34: Dc in each st around [30 dc]

Round 35: (Dc in next 3 st, dc2tog) 6 times [24 dc]

Round 36: (Dc in next 2 st, dc2tog) 6 times [18 dc]

Round 37: (Dc in next, dc2tog) 6 times [12 dc]

Round 38: (Dc2tog) 6 times [6 dc]

Fasten off leaving a short tail. Using a sewing needle, thread the tail through the front loop of each of the remaining stitches and pull tight. Sew in any ends.

To shape the eyes, using a sewing needle and a strand of lemon, pass needle through the back of the head and pull through just above the eye. Work a small horizontal stitch, pass the needle through to the other side and work another small horizontal stitch just above the second eye. Pass needle back to the first eye and this time work a small horizontal stitch underneath the eye. Repeat on the other side. Pull thread tight. This will form slight indents allowing the eyes to sink in slightly as pictured. Fasten off.

Embroider the eye lashes and eyebrows as pictured. Work a small triangle in candyfloss pink for the nose, then work a vertical line starting at the bottom point of the nose. Using the side of a red colouring pencil, lightly shade the cheeks.



### **Inner Ears (make 2)**

Using lilac and a 2.5mm hook, ch 4.

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next 3 sts, ch 1. Turn [3 dc]

Rows 2-5: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [3 dc] Row 6: Dc in next st, 2dc in next st, dc in last st. Ch1. Turn [4 dc]

Rows 7-10: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [4 dc] Row 11: Dc in next st, (2dc in next st) twice, dc in last st. Ch1. Turn [6 dc]

Rows 12-16: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [6 dc] Row 17: Dc in next st, (2dc in next st) 4 times, dc in last st. Ch1. Turn [10 dc]

Rows 18-22: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [10 dc] Row 23: Dc in next 2 st (Dc2tog) 3 times, dc in next 2 sts. Ch 1. Turn [7 sts]

Rows 24-26: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [7 dc] Row 27: Dc in next st, (dc2tog, dc in next st) twice. Ch1. Turn. [5 dc]

Rows 28-30: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [5 dc] Row 31: Dc in next st, dc3tog, sc in last st. Ch 1. Turn [3 dc]

Row 32: Dc in each st to end. Ch 1. Turn [5 dc] Row 33: Without turning, dc around the entire edge of the inner ear.

Fasten off and sew in any ends.

# Outer Ears (make 2)

Using Lemon and a 2.5mm hook, ch 4.

Repeat Rounds 1-33 of the inner ear.

Place an inner ear on top of the outer ear so it is facing you. Insert hook through first dc crochet of round 32 of both pieces. Using lemon, continue to dc around the edge of both pieces, thus joining them together.

Fasten off. Sew ears to bunny as pictured.



## Legs (make 2)

Using lilac and a 2.5mm hook, make a magic loop.

Round 1: 2dc in each st around. [12 dc]

Round 2: Dc in first 2 st, 2dc in next st, dc in next 2 st, 3htr in the next st, htr in next 2 st, 3htr in next st, dc in the next 2 st, 2dc in the last st [18 dc]

Round 3: Dc in first 3 st, 2dc in next st, dc in next 2 st, htr in next st, 2htr in the next st, htr in next 4 st, 2htr in next st, htr in next st, dc in next st, 2dc in next st, dc in next 2 st [22 dc]

Break off lilac and join on lemon.

Round 4: Change to light yellow. 2dc in first st, dc in next 8 st, 3htr in next st, htr in next 5 st, 3htr in next st, dc in next 6 [27]

Round 5: Dc in each st around [27 dc]

Round 6: Dc in first st, dc2tog, dc in next 8 st, dc2tog, dc

in next 6, dc2tog, dc in last 6 [24 dc]

Round 7: Dc in first 11 st, htr3tog, htr in next 3 st,

htr3tog, dc in next 4 st [20 dc]

Round 8: Dc in first 3st, dc2tog, dc in next 4 st, (dc2tog, dc in next st) twice, dc2tog, dc in last 3 st [16 dc]
Round 9: Dc in next 11 st, dc2tog, dc in last 3 st [15 dc]
Rounds 11-12: Dc in each st around [15 dc]

Taking care not to stretch the stitches, stuff the leg firmly. Continue stuffing as you go

Round 13: (Dc in next 3 st, dc2tog) rep 3 times. [12 dc] Rounds 14-15: Dc in each st around [12 dc] Round 16: dc in next 5 st, dc2tog, dc in next 5 st [11 dc] Rounds 17-18: Dc in each st around [11 dc] Round 19: Dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog) to last 3 st, dc2tog, dc in last st [8 dc]

Fasten Off and sew in any ends. Sew legs to body as pictured.



# Arms (make 2)

Using lemon and a 2.5mm hook, make a magic loop.

Round 1: Ch1, 6dc into loop [6 dc]

Round 2: Work 2 dc in each st around [12 dc]

Round 3: (Dc in next 5 sts, 2dc in next st) twice [14 dc]

Round 4: (Dc in next 6 sts, 2dc in next st) twice [16 dc]

Rounds 5-6: Dc in each st around [16 dc]

Round 7: (Dc in next 6 sts, dc2tog) twice [14 dc]

Round 8: (Dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog) twice [12 dc]

Stuff arms lightly. Continue to stuff as you go

Rounds 9-10: Dc in each st around [12 dc]

Round 11: (Dc in next 4 sts, dc2tog) twice [10 dc]

Rounds 12-13: Dc in each st around [10 dc]

Round 14: (Dc in next 3 sts, dc2tog) twice [8 dc]

Rounds 15-18: Dc in each st around [8 dc]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew to either side of body as pictured.



**Tail**Using cream and a 2.5mm hook, make a magic loop

Round 1: Ch1, 6dc into loop [6 dc]

Round 2: Working in the FRONT LOOPS ONLY, dc in

next st, (ch 6, dc in next st) rep to end. [6 dc]

Round 3: Fold the chains of 6 forward to reveal the unused back loops from round 1. Working in these BACK LOOPS ONLY, work 2 dc in each st around. [12]

Round 4: Working in the FRONT LOOPS ONLY, dc in

next st, (ch 6, dc in next st) rep to end.

Round 5: Dc in each st around [12 dc]

Round 6: Working in the FRONT LOOPS ONLY, dc in

next st, (ch 6, dc in next st) rep to end. [12 dc]

Round 7: Fold the chains of 6 forward to reveal the unused back loops from round 5. Working in these

BACK LOOPS ONLY, (dc2tog) 6 times [6 dc]

Fasten Off. Sew tail to the back of the bunny.
