A Crochet Pattern by Cartlers Designs



Kelsey Dress

This pattern uses Crochet Stitches

Materials

No 10 Cotton Peach and Black 1.75mm Hook 3 tiny buttons.

Abbreviations

Dc = double crochet Ch = chain Trcl = treble cluster Slst = slip stitch Dtr = double treble Shell = 2dtr,2ch,2dtr Lshell = 2dtr,5ch,2dtr Sp = space Rep = repeat *-* = repeat between

TOP SKIRT Row 1. Ch 40 + 4.

Row 2. 3trcl in 5th chain from hook, 9ch, * 4trcl, 9ch, * rep across row, turn

Row 3. *6dc, ch2, 6dc all in 9ch loop, * rep across row, join with slst to beg st.

Rnd 4. Slst to ch2 sp, shell in ch2 sp, * 7ch, shell in ch2 sp, * slst to join.

Rnd 5. Shell in shell of previous row, * 3ch, 1dc in ch loop, 3ch, 1dc in ch loop, 3ch, shell in shell* slst to join.

Rnd 6. Shell in shell of previous row, * 4ch, 1dc in 3ch sp, 2ch, 1dc in same 3ch sp, 4ch, shell in shell * slst to join.

Rnd 7. Lshell in shell of prev row, * 5ch, 1dc in 3ch sp, 5ch, Lshell in shell* slst to join.

Rnd 8. In Lshell sp work, *12 dtr, 2ch, 2dtrcl (working either side of dc in centre of ch) 2ch, * sl st to join.

Rnd 9. Miss first dtr,* work 1dtr, 1ch in each dtr, *miss last dtr, (no chain space between groups of dtr)

Rnd 10. As rnd 9 but working 2ch instead of 1ch.

Rnd 11. As rnd 10 but working 3ch instead of 2ch.

Rnd 12. 4dc in each 3ch sp, 5ch loop,* 4dc in 3ch sp, 5ch loop*, slst to join. Fasten off.

UNDERSKIRT

Working on the opposite side of the starting chain of overskirt.

Row 1. Work 1dc in each st.

Row 2. 1dtr in ach dc to end.

Row 3. 1dtr in each dtr to end.

Row 4. *1dtr in next 3 sts, 2dtr in next st.* to end.

Row 5. 1dtr in each dtr. Slst to join.

Rnd 6. 1dtr in each dtr, slst to join.

Rnd 7. Rep row 4. Slst to join.

Rnd 8. Rep row 5. Slst to join.

Rnd 9. Rep row 4. Slst to join.

Rnd 10. *1dtr, 2dtr in next st, * rep to end. slst to join.

Rnd 11. 1dtr in each st around. Slst to join.

Fasten off.

TOP

Row 1. With RS facing and peach, work 1tr between each tr on first row of skirt. =42sts.

Row 2. Work 2trtog, tr across to last 2 sts 2trtog. = 40sts.

Row 3. Rep row 2. = 38 sts.

Row 4-8. Tr in each tr to end.

Row 9. Dc in next 7tr, ch13, miss 4 sts, dc in next 14 tr, ch13, miss 4 sts, dc in next 7tr.

Row 10. 3ch, tr in 5tr, 3trtog, (taking in first ch) 1tr in each ch to last ch, 3trtog using last ch st. Miss 2sts, *tr, ch2, tr in next st, miss 2 sts, * rep twice, 3trtog (taking in first ch) 1tr in each ch, 3trtog at end of ch, tr to end.

Turn the work sideways and work 2tr into the end of each tr row. Work around complete back opening ending at the top. Finish off.

Sew in all ends.

Sew on buttons.

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
