# Pattern "Happy days fingerless mittens"

Size - 7/9 years -10/12 years

Difficulty level — beginner

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## **Preparations:**

1. Yarn of group B/ 3 DK/ worsted/ 8 ply - 100 m (109 yds) / 50 g (1,8 oz):

45 - 70 g (1.6 - 2.5 oz).

For example, DROPS Lima, DROPS Karisma, MONDIAL Australia, OUTLAW YARN Bandit, SVARTA FÅRET Ulrika, PAINTBOX YARNS 100% Wool Worsted Superwash, COEUR D'ALENE Superwash Merino, PATONS Smoothie

DK, LAMANA Cosma, KING COLE Baby Alpaca DK, FYBERSPATES Vivacious DK, LION BRAND LB Collection Cotton Jeans, BERNAT Softee Cotton.

- 2. Crochet hooks 4.0 and 3.5 mm.
- 3. Scissors.
- 4. Markers.
- 5. Measuring tape.


### Gauge:


22 sc BLO x 16 rows = 10 cm/4 inch in width and 10 cm/4 inch vertically for 3.5 mm hook size, or size needed to get.


25 ss x 24 rows = 10 cm/ 4 inch in width and 10 cm/ 4 inch vertically for 3.5 mm hook size, or size needed to get.

## Stitch types (US terms):














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
Single crochet 短針 (sc)







## Single crochet back loop only (sc BLO)












# Surface slip stitch



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## **MITTEN:**

With 4.0 mm hook 31-38 chains.

**Row 1:** Work into the back bump of Foundation Chains (or like you prefer): it makes the edge neater. With 3.5 mm hook 10-12 ss (1<sup>st</sup> ss in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain counted from the hook), 20-25 sc, turn.

**Row 2:** Chain 1, 20-25 sc BLO, 10-12 ss, turn.

Row 3: Chain 1, 10-12 ss (1st ss in 2nd stitch from hook), 20-25 sc BLO, turn.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

**Row 5:** Repeat Row 3.

Row 6: Repeat Row 2.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 8:** Repeat Row 2.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 10:** Repeat Row 2.

Row 11: Repeat Row 3.

Row 12: Repeat Row 2.

Row 13: Repeat Row 3.

Row 14: Repeat Row 2.



After Row 14 (Size 6/9 years)

!!Rows 14.1-14.4 only for Size 10/12 years. For Sizes 7/9 years skip Rows 14.1-14.4.

**Row 14.1:** Chain 1, 12 ss ( $1^{st}$  ss in  $2^{nd}$  stitch from hook), 25 sc BLO, turn.

Row 14.2: Chain 1, 25 sc BLO, 12 ss, turn.

Row 14.3: Repeat Row 14.1.

Row 14.4: Repeat Row 14.2.

**Row 15:** Chain 1, 20-25 sc BLO, turn, leaving next 10-12 stitches of the Row 14 or Row 14.4.

**Row 16:** Chain 1, 20-25 sc BLO, turn.

Rows 17-24: Repeat Row 16.





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**Row 25:** Chain 1, 10-12 ss (1<sup>st</sup> ss in 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch from hook), 10-13 sc BLO, 10-12 sc BLO in leaving 10-12 stitches of the Row 14 or Row 14.4, turn.

Row 26: Repeat Row 2.

Row 27: Repeat Row 3.

Row 28: Repeat Row 2.

Row 29: Repeat Row 3.

Row 30: Repeat Row 2.

Row 31: Repeat Row 3.

Row 32: Repeat Row 2.

Row 33: Repeat Row 3.

Row 34: Repeat Row 2.

Row 35: Repeat Row 3.

Row 36: Repeat Row 2.

Row 37: Repeat Row 3.

Row 38: Repeat Row 2.





!!Rows 38.1-38.4 only for Size 10/12 years. For Sizes 7/9 years skip Rows 38.1-38.4.

**Row 38.1:** Chain 1, 12 ss ( $1^{st}$  ss in  $2^{nd}$  stitch from hook), 25 sc BLO, turn.

Row 38.2: Chain 1, 25 sc BLO, 12 ss, turn.

**Row 38.3:** Repeat Row 38.1.

Row 38.4: Repeat Row 38.2.

Don't cut the yarn.

#### **ASSEMBLY:**

Fold the mitten double alongside, and make a seam:

1<sup>st</sup> Way: Make side seam with surface slip stitch, cut and fasten the yarn.

2<sup>nd</sup> Way: Cut the yarn, keep it long and use it to sew side seam, cut and fasten the yarn.

Make the other mitten the same way.


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## **Hoop-de-doo!** Mittens are finished!
